For good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I agree that, if appointed and approved to participate in the Tournament as Tournament Official (Coach, EO, Umpire, Scorer, Coordinator or other), I will observe and comply with all reasonable requirements of the tournament respecting conduct and service, both on and off the field and, in conjunction therewith, I agree as follows:

I understand that this Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties in connection with the tournament, is personal to me and shall not be assigned or transferred, in whole or in part, nor may it be modified or revoked except in writing signed by both parties, and I confirm that I will abide by its terms.
