## MOMENTS THAT MATTER: Every Action Can Create Change

**NO MORE** was founded in the Northern Territory in 2006 by Gurindji man and ABC commentator Dr Charlie King AM. It is a whole-of-community campaign that uses the power of sport to challenge harmful attitudes, promote respect and help create safer communities.

Baseball Australia has proudly partnered with **NO MORE** since 2014. Through this partnership, baseball has helped amplify the message that everyone has a role to play in ending domestic and family violence.



**NO MORE** Day is an opportunity for us to stand together against domestic and family violence. This year's theme is built on the idea that small actions matter, and that we can all help create safe, respectful and inclusive environments on and off the field.

Players are encouraged to use their influence by starting conversations, calling out disrespectful behaviour, supporting someone who needs it, and making a personal commitment to learn more.

If any of this feels close to your own experience, remember there is support available whenever you are ready.

## PLAYERS ROLE

On NO MORE Day, players are asked to take part in activities that show unity and support towards ending domestic and family violence.

1. Wear an orange NO MORE sleeve during games as a sign of collective commitment.
2. Players are encouraged to place NO MORE stickers on batting helmets before or on NO MORE Day, although using the stickers is optional.
3. Before each game both teams and umpires will line up on the diamond and link arms for a photo to show solidarity against domestic violence. When linking arms keep open relaxed palms, pair with someone of similar height where possible, and its ok to smile to reflect hope and positive change.

## SPIRIT OF THE GAME AWARDS

This year's Spirit of the Game Awards will recognise one person from each championship who takes a stand in the **moments that matter**, by showing respect, calling out poor behaviour, supporting others and leading a safe, inclusive environment that reflects NO MORE and Baseball Australia's values
